**3. LATE FRENCH IMMERSION PROGRAM:**

**3.1 Program Requirements**

- 3.1.1 Applicants for enrolment must meet all program requirements for the requested educational program and will be subject to any selection process established for that program.
- 3.1.2 Students MUST be registered at their catchment area schools, where the catchment areas are as defined in Appendix A, then apply to the Late French Immersion program. If successful, applicants will automatically receive school of choice.

**3.2 Application Process**

- 3.2.1 Application for Late French Immersion must be received at the Board office by noon on February 1 of each year (should February 1 fall on a weekend the deadline will be at noon on the first school day after February 1). As part of the application process, applicants must select their school of choice to attend.
- 3.2.2 The number of Late French Immersion classrooms and in which schools these classrooms will reside will be decided by the Superintendent or designate based on the number of applications received as per 3.2.1. This information will be reported to the Board of Education at its next regular meeting.
- 3.2.3 The classrooms will be filled by random selection of all applications received by the deadline in 3.2.1, until they are at capacity, in the following order:
  - a. In-school district students;
  - b. Non-school district students.
- 3.2.4 The number of Late French Immersion classrooms and in which schools these classrooms will reside will be confirmed by the Board of Education when it passes the budget during its regular budget process.

**3.3 Wait List**

For applications for Late French Immersion made before the application deadline, wait list position is determined in accordance with the random selection process under 3.2 above. Applications received after the application deadline are added to any wait list according to date/time order received.
