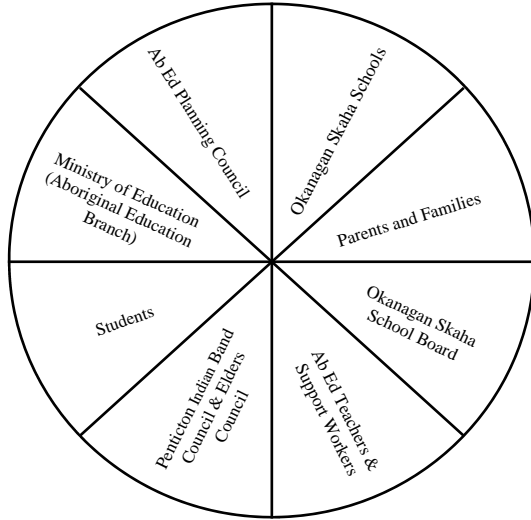
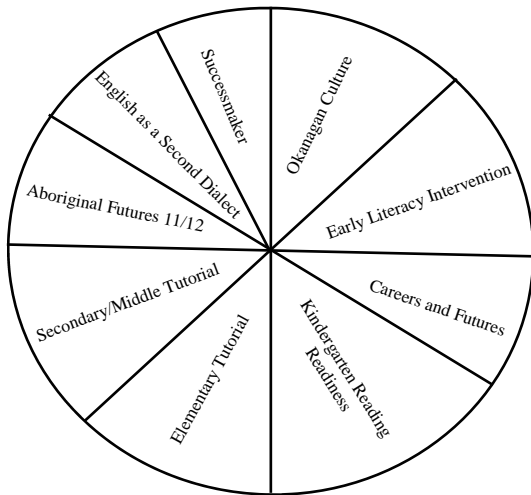

Aboriginal Education Program

Aboriginal Education Elementary School Teaching (1.0 teacher/4 support workers)

- ◇ Provide early success instruction to qualifying Aboriginal children (Grades K-3)
- ◇ Work with pupils to increase classroom success
- ◇ Encourage the inclusion of Aboriginal culture in the elementary schools
- ◇ Assist school based educators serving elementary Aboriginal students
- ◇ Work with parents to strengthen the home-school team
- ◇ Teacher provides advice and direction to Aboriginal Education Support Workers
- ◇ Teacher directs the elementary tutorial service

Aboriginal Education Middle School Teaching (0.5 teacher/2 support workers)

- ◇ Work with Aboriginal students to increase classroom success
- ◇ Provide counseling and support to middle school Aboriginal students
- ◇ Encourage the inclusion of Aboriginal culture in the middle schools
- ◇ Assist school based educators serving middle school Aboriginal students
- ◇ Work with parents to strengthen the home-school team
- ◇ Teacher provides advice and direction to Aboriginal Education Support Workers

Aboriginal Education Counselor (1.0)

- ◇ Provides counseling and support to students at all levels
- ◇ Assists school based educators serving Aboriginal students
- ◇ Works with parents to strengthen the home-school team
- ◇ Is a member of the District Crisis Team

Aboriginal Education Secondary School Teaching (1.5 teachers/1 support worker)

- ◇ Work with Aboriginal students to increase class room success
- ◇ Provide counseling and support to secondary school Aboriginal students
- ◇ Assist school based educators serving secondary Aboriginal students
- ◇ Work with parents to strengthen the home-school team
- ◇ Teacher teaches Aboriginal Futures at Princess Margaret and Penticton Secondary Schools
- ◇ Support First Nation Studies 12 at the high schools
- ◇ Facilitate the secondary/post secondary transition for Aboriginal students
