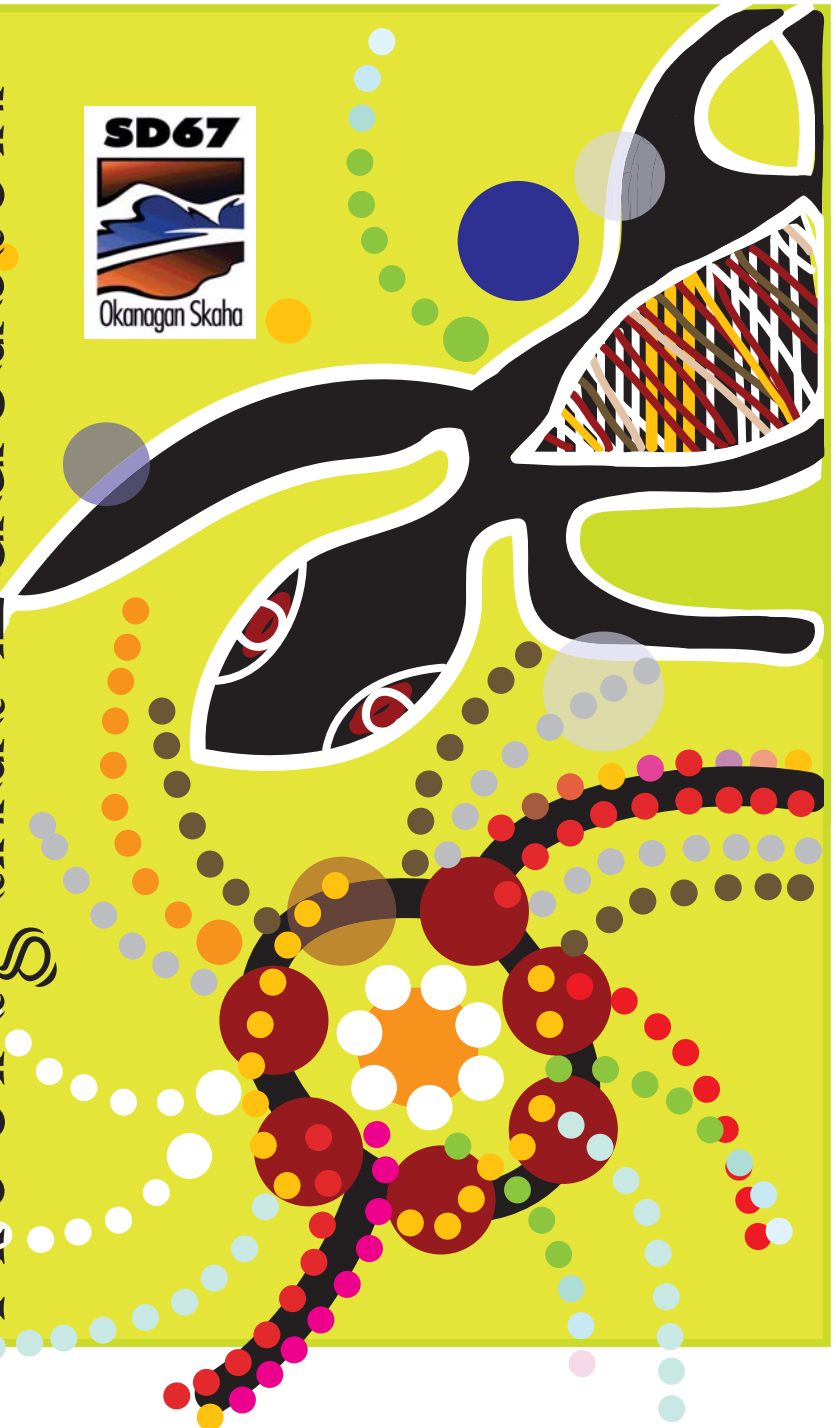

Elementary School Teaching (1.0 teacher / 3 support workers)

- Provide early success instruction to qualifying Aboriginal children (grades K - 3)
- Work with pupils to increase classroom success
- Encourage the inclusion of Aboriginal culture in the elementary schools
- Assist school based educators serving elementary Aboriginal students
- Work with parents to strengthen the home-school team
- Teacher provides advice and direction to Aboriginal Education Support Workers
- Teacher directs the elementary tutorial service

Middle School Teaching (0.5 teacher / 2 support workers)

- Work with Aboriginal students to increase classroom success
- Provide counselling and support to middle school Aboriginal students
- Encourage the inclusion of Aboriginal culture in the middle schools
- Assist school based educators servicing middle school Aboriginal students
- Work with parents to strengthen the home-school team
- Teacher provides advice and direction to Aboriginal Education Support Workers

Secondary School Teaching (1.0 teacher / 1 support worker)

- Work with Aboriginal students to increase classroom success
- Provide counselling and support to secondary school Aboriginal students
- Assist school based educators serving secondary Aboriginal students
- Work with parents to strengthen the home-school team
- Teacher teaches Aboriginal Futures at Princess Margaret and Penticton Secondary Schools
- Support First Nation Studies 12 at the high schools
- Facilitate the secondary/post secondary transition for Aboriginal students
