**Celebrating a Century**

Penticton will mark its 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 2008. The Centennial Advisory Committee, appointed by Penticton City Council, is a volunteer group charged with the responsibility of encouraging the community to adopt the Centennial theme and to join in yearlong celebrations that will culminate on New Year's Eve 2008. Three students from the committee (Tyler Guy, Teresa Johnston and Chelsea Terry), accompanied by Sharon Amos, Chair, Centennial Advisory Committee, highlighted plans for the celebrations including a number of ideas for youth and school activities they would like to see take place during 2008. These included an art mural and banners to be completed by art students from Penticton Secondary and Princess Margaret Secondary schools, a video production created by media students which could be used as a teaching tool, and a musical theatre production. Financial support, in the amount of \$10,000, was requested for these projects as well as the purchase of five hundred books on the history of Penticton, currently being written, for use in school libraries and as class sets for each school. Additionally, the students requested letters of support for information being sent to the schools.
