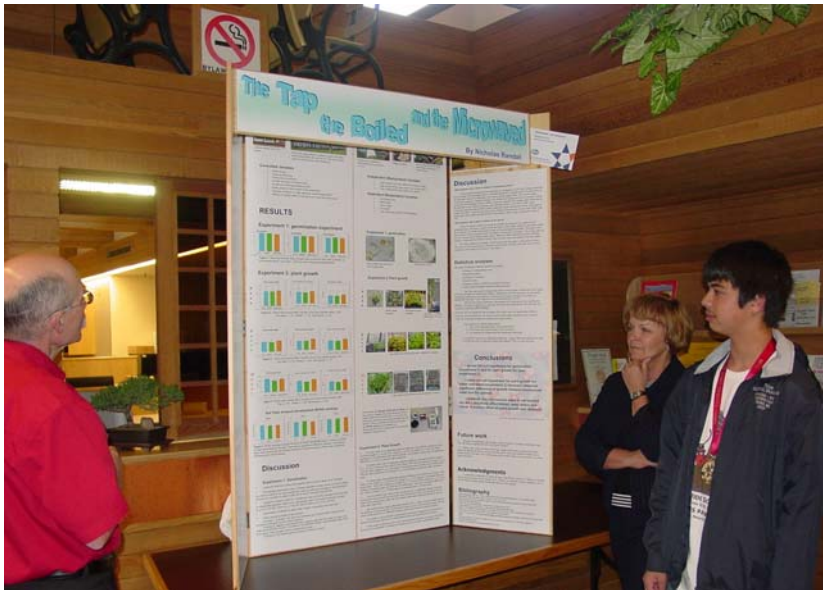
Canada-Wide Science Fair Awards
