Summer School 2008

Summer School Principal Allen Beckingham presented the 2008 Summer School report noting that when the Ministry of Education changed its policy on summer school funding, it caused the school district to review and redesign some parts of the program. The revised program resulted in additional work in the management areas of communicating the changes at each of our schools, registration (increased enrolment), processing course deposits (and returning deposits upon course completion), and preparing data for the required 1701 submission (new school, new classes, and importing student data). Each course was reviewed to ensure the curriculum had direct links to the prescribed learning outcomes. Three hundred and ninety-two students participated in the one and two-week courses and feedback was very favourable. The summer school was delivered by 19 teachers with support from two volunteer education assistants enrolled in the Okanagan College EA program. Mr. Beckingham extended appreciation to clerical and technology staff for their efforts in making the program a success.
