

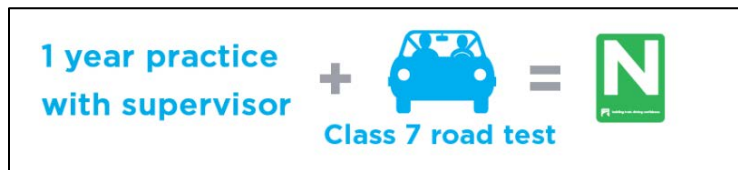


School District No. 67 (Okanagan Skaha) INTERNATIONAL STUDENT PROGRAM

“N” Driver Double Approval

Completing this form is necessary before International Students can ride with new “N” drivers.

British Columbia has a graduated licencing program for young drivers.



This program places restrictions on inexperienced drivers. The restrictions placed on new “N” drivers are;

No blood alcohol: You must not drive with any alcohol in your body

Display N sign: Display N sign on the back of your vehicle

No electronic devices: No hand-held or hands-free electronic devices

Limit one passenger: 1 passenger only (immediate family exempt) unless with supervisor age 25+

To allow International Students to ride with Canadian students who have an “N” drivers licence, students must receive double approval from both their natural parents and their host parents. This must be done for each individual “N” driver students may be riding with.
