

Graduation Requirements for International Students in BC

General Requirements (80 credits – at least 16 must be Grade 12 credits)

In order to graduate, students must pass specific courses. Overall, each student must acquire 80 credits from a combination of required courses, elective courses and the Graduation Transitions program.

Required Courses (48 credits)

A. The following courses must be completed by a Certified BC Teacher

- Planning 10 or Career Life Education 10 (4 credits)
- a Language Arts 11 (4 credits)
- a Language Arts 12 (4 credits)
- a Mathematics 11 or 12 (4 credits)
- a Science 11 or 12 (4 credits)
- Social Studies 11 or Social Studies 12 - Law 12, BC First Nation Studies 12, Geography 12 (4 credits)

B. The following courses are required courses that can be completed in other countries or provinces. *Credit gained through equivalency process
