POLICY #300 Student Registration

RATIONALE

The Board is obligated to provide educational programs and services for eligible students who live within the geographical boundaries of the school district. This eligibility is defined in Policy #305 – Choice and Flexibility.

POLICY

Students who are resident within the school district are generally expected to attend their neighbourhood school according to catchment areas defined by the Board of Education.

Space permitting, students may attend a school outside their catchment area.

REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES

POLICY #300 Student Registration

1. Maps of the school district defining the catchment areas for each school will be maintained. Amendments to a school's catchment area must be approved by the Board.
2. Parents of students desiring to have their child attend a school outside of their catchment area may request a transfer.
3. School bus transportation may not be available to students whose parents have requested a transfer to a school outside the student's catchment area.
4. Students whose residence changes during the school year may either stay at their current school, or attend the school in their new catchment area if space and educational service permit.
